My paintings are a reflection of the many faces of America.

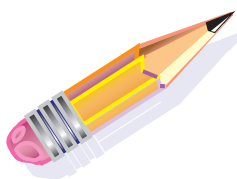
I want to present "Chicago On Parade" to you.
